Hello, my name is Valentina Kober and I'm from Ukraine. The last 5 years I'm living in Greece and more specifically in Larissa where I'm working as a radio producer in the Power FM.

I decided to work there firstly because it was a field where I could speak mostly English and find material in English, since I didn't know Greek well. Secondly, it was a small company, like a family business, so they were patient with my difficulties in adjusting and there was a very friendly and cooperative environment to work in.

The fact that I didn't speak the native language when I first came made it difficult to adjust and keep up with many activities at work. Also, the legislation about immigrants is very complicated so there were issues arising constantly regarding my hiring and employment.

The advice that I'm going to give to ethnic minorities women that want to start an enterprise is that they have always to stay informed. Search very carefully what is needed for your field, learn everything about your civil and occupational rights and don't stop until you gather all the existing information. Take advice and consultation from experts on the employment field and record any actions taken or material shared.
