

Hello, I am Yelyzeveta Kravchenko.

I am from Ukraine, I am deputy manager of this organization (Disabled Foundation) centre of disabled people. For five years we help disabled people to live in more successful and happy in our world.

It was interesting because... I think when you have some desire university gave you a option to make it. So I applied to Erasmus+ on their website... and I could continue on my volunteering in social entrepreneur jobs.

The first difficulty, I think we and all world have Corona Virus...also world economic situation and also people are very afraid. But we should remember every day, we should continue our work. Next, it is not good...laws in Ukrainian do not know about the situation in Turkey. But the law is very important. Because if government start only thinking about how to make war... start more thinking about people, about disabled people... this allows who can help social entrepreneur continues that work. It will be very cool.

I know the huge success is because, I do not know good Turkish language, and also our member in this centre, disabled people also do not know English. But you are here to understand that, when you have good emotion you really want to help people, it does not matter that you do not know language each other. It can help you to understand everybody.

And we see like people, member of this organisation disabled people after our lesson, they really start more good. They wash hair, brush their teeth, prepare food for their lunch. This is a benefit... for member of our organisation...they become more open to this world...they are utilizing this world. They understand how and what should to do or not what should to do. How prepare...take care of herself. Our examples show them, they should not feel they are disabled. Because our universe, our world is so big. In this world everyone has supplies when wants to be happy and successful.

First of all, it is basis maybe, yes, how to take care for themselves, about how to go to bath, how to clean face, how to wash hands, how you prepare yourself when you want to go out. What you should do when you have lunch time? How you should prepare for lunch time? How to make service at the table if you have a dish, and how you clean yourself after? [We give them information about hygiene.]

Some advantages, do not start feeling that they are disabled. Because he spoke to us, they understand the smile... he wants to talk... we are all open to them. They do not need to sit like a boxes. They should go out, also show how he can be cool, in this... maybe not good opportunity.

First of all, every women should ask truly if she needs to do this. Because it is a work, you should understand. Sometimes it is very hard and emotional work.
